Directions to the event are as follows-

Take Hwy 61 to the Hwy 47/Troy exit. Turn into Troy (Left if your headed northbound, right if your headed southbound) and go through town past Walmart and everything. Just past the elementary school which will be on your left side, Fairgrounds Road will be on your right side. Turn right onto Fairgrounds Road and follow traffic to the fair grounds.

You will pull up to the main gate to unload and then you will go park. Come through the main gate with your dog, and proceed to the Dockdogs crating area to checking in or register. Your dog CAN NOT go out into the fair grounds with you at any point in time. When you are ready to head out for the night, you can pull back up to the main gate to load your vehicle up.

We hope to see everyone there!
